Functional Skills Maths (Level 2) is a requirement for many Higher Education courses and employers. If you want to improve your knowledge of number, algebra, probability, geometry, and statistics, this course will support you in achieving this vital qualification.

You will study in a focused but welcoming environment, with expert lecturers guiding you through group and individual activities to develop your confidence and skills. A recommended textbook will support your learning, and you will be expected to attend weekly classes and complete regular homework assignments.

## What You Will Study

Part-Time Functional Skills Maths:

1. Entry Level: Topics may include numbers, fractions, money, decimals, time, shape, and data handling.
2. Levels 1 & 2: Covers all aspects of numeracy, including problem-solving, interpreting information, and calculating measurements.
