3 GCSEs at Grade 9-3, including English and Maths and a satisfactory interview/audition.

OR

Level 1 Music, Performance & Production Arts at Merit Grade

AND

Level 1 English and Maths

PLUS

Satisfactory interview/audition.

Please prepare a piece of music on your chosen instrument. Amps, keyboards and drum kits will be supplied but please bring your own chosen instrument. Please reply to the admissions@heartofyorkshire.ac.uk email stating which instrument you play. When you attend your interview, please bring along your latest school report, and your predicted grades.
