It provides a thorough understanding of how to support children and young people's learning, development, and wellbeing within the framework of the school curriculum.

Learners will gain both the theoretical understanding and practical experience necessary to make a positive impact in the classroom and to contribute to an inclusive and supportive learning environment.

Who is this qualification for?

This course is suitable for:

- Individuals working or volunteering in a school or college setting supporting pupils' learning.
- Those who have completed a Level 2 qualification in Supporting Teaching and Learning and wish to progress.
- Adults seeking a career change into education or classroom support roles. Learners must be working or volunteering in a school or college environment as practical placement hours are required for assessment.
